

Tuition, Payment & Fees

We do not bill by the class. Like an academy or private school, we automatically charge your account on the 1st of each month. Any failed transactions will be charged an additional \$35 and enrollment will be suspended until payment has cleared. All automatic payments are active until the end of May 2023 or until RockPrep receives a 30-day written notice of withdrawal.

Registration Fees

- An annual Registration Fee is required for all students upon enrollment.
 - o \$40 for the first family member
 - o \$10 for each additional family member

*Methods of Payment Accepted

RockPrep requires an active credit card or ACH number to be kept on file. Students may not attend lessons until all financial forms have been signed and submitted.

- Recurring eCheck/ACH bank draft
- Recurring Credit Card/Debit Card

Lesson/Session Fees

- Tuition and fees are a fixed flat monthly rate for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Tuition and fees are automatically drafted on the 1st day of each month.

Miscellaneous Fees

• Miscellaneous fees such as musical instruments, method books, supplies, art supplies, costumes, etc. will be due at various times throughout the season.

If payment is not received by the 5th day of month

- A late fee of \$35 will be automatically applied via credit card or eCheck (on file).
- Students may NOT attend lessons if tuition is outstanding. The student will not be allowed to attend future lessons until the balance is paid in FULL for the current month.

^{*} No credit and no refunds will be given for personal absences, holidays, inclement weather or school closing.

- 3. Begin lessons/classes.

Scheduling & Approval

Once the registration process is complete (including receipt of payment), students may begin lessons, classes, groups & camps outside of school hours. No special approval is needed for enrichment outside of school hours.

For Lessons During School Day

Prior approval is needed for lessons taken during the school day according to each RockPrep location. Please refer to your instructor for necessary approvals.

For GFCS students (only):

Students (preK-12th grade) may take one lesson per week during school hours in accordance with the following:

- 1. Students involved in any pull-out program Ex. GFCS Worth St. Campus ALP, ASP, Language therapy, Learning Lab) are not eligible for daytime lessons.
- 2. Students must have approval from administration and the PE/elective teacher whose class is being missed.
- 3. 6th-12th grade students may only schedule lessons during PE during the off season (when they are not participating in a school sport).
- 4. 6th-12th grade students must check in with their PE/elective teacher PRIOR to attending lessons each week to ensure accurate roll is taken.

For LCCS students (only):

Students (preK-12th grade) may take one lesson per week during school hours in accordance with the following:

- 1. Students involved in any pull-out program Ex. Language therapy, Learning Lab, etc. are not eligible for daytime lessons.
- 2. Students must have approval from administration and the PE/elective teacher whose class is being missed.
- 3. 6th-12th grade students may only schedule lessons during PE during the off season (when they are not participating in a school sport).
- 4. 6th-12th grade students must check in with their PE/elective teacher PRIOR to attending lessons each week to ensure accurate roll is taken.



Attendance & Make Ups

In order to enable students to steward their gifts, regular attendance is vital. There are no refunds or credits for personal absences. Tuition for private lessons and sessions is a reservation of time and guarantee of a standing weekly appointment with your RockPrep instructor. RockPrep expects at least 24 hour notification of all planned absences and as much notice as possible for any unexpected absences. Please call, text or email your instructor at least 24 hours in advance of planned absences and as soon as possible regarding unexpected absences.

All RockPrep instructor absences (expected or otherwise) <u>will be rescheduled</u> within one week of the absence by your current RockPrep instructor. In the event that your RockPrep instructor is unable to make the lesson/session up within the given week, you may choose to reschedule at a later specific day/time. If rescheduling at a later day/time is not an option, RockPrep will assign a substitute instructor to make the lesson/session up. Special options for Monday/Friday students are available. Please work with your instructor (at least one week in advance) in order to create a rescheduling plan for at least one Monday/Friday school holiday.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Decisions regarding inclement weather will be communicated via email. Missed lessons, classes or sessions due to Inclement Weather may or may not be rescheduled (at the discretion of RockPrep).

CANCELLATION/WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal from monthly lessons/classes prior to the end of the season, requires:

- Written notice to RockPrep: <u>RockPrep@Gmail.com</u> AND
- 2) Written notice to your current RockPrep instructor 30 days prior to the first day of the next month.

Failure to give written notice will result in tuition being charged to your account and automatic payment will be processed without refund. If you attend any part of the month, you are responsible for the full month's tuition.

As you may know, we constantly seek out the most talented, qualified and godly enrichment Instructors for our families. In order to provide the highest quality of Instructors, we have a written agreement with each of our Instructors. If they discontinue providing instruction to RockPrep families, each Instructor agrees not to provide services to our families for a period of one year. By signing here, you agree to honor that commitment, as well.

BEHAVIOR & DISCIPLINE

We are committed to having a safe, nurturing and fun place where students can discover the creative, develop their skills and delight in the process.
